## SAFETY NOTICE

'TOP' STAFF CAR PARK (i.e. Car Park to Main Entrance to school)

In the interests of the safety of students, staff and visitors to the school, with effect from Monday 8 January 2007 (first day students are back at school following the Christmas/New Year holiday) the gates to the above car park will be closed from 2.45pm to 3.15pm.

No vehicles will be allowed in or out of the car park between these times. This action is necessary in order to ensure the safety of large numbers of students and others leaving school at the end of the school day.

This is a staff car park and is accessible to emergency vehicles and to parents and visitors ONLY in emergency situations during the day. In all other circumstances visitors should use the main car park to the east (Woodhouse) end of the school site.

Visitors to school or the City Learning Centre may use the top car park subject to spaces being available after 3.30 pm.
