Can the staff band stand another slating?

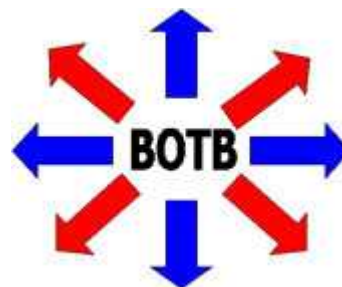
Can the judges get any meaner?

Year 7 Inter Personal Tutor Group Cricket Competition

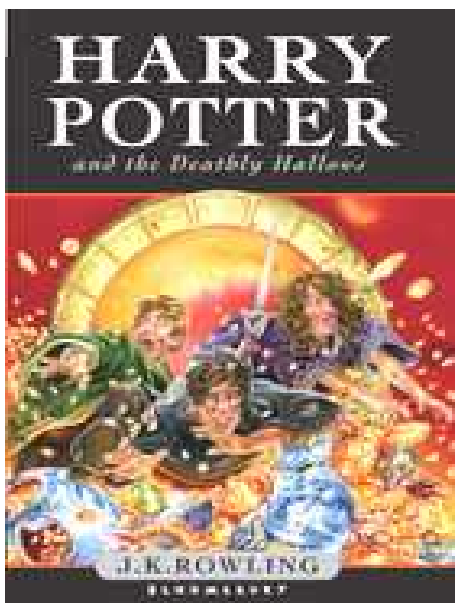
Congratulations to the team from 7.5 who beat 7.8 in the final of this competition.
